## Making a Call May Save a Life

CHIERS, a medically staffed van operated by local nonprofit Central City Concern (CCC), responds to people who are intoxicated or incapacitated by drugs/alcohol. We rely on people and businesses like you to be alerted to those in need of help.

Upon receiving your call, CHIERS EMT staff will evaluate the individual and transport him/ her to CCC's Sobering Station where they can get sober in a safe, medically-supervised environment. Individuals are released in approximately 4 to 8 hours.

If you see an intoxicated individual who appears to be passed out or acting in a manner dangerous to themselves or others around them:
