**Todd Engstrom, M.D.**  
**Joins Old Town Clinic Staff**

Central City Concern (CCC) announces that Dr. Todd Engstrom has joined the primary care team at Old Town Clinic. Dr. Engstrom has concurrently joined the faculty at Oregon Health & Science University's (OHSU) Division of General Internal Medicine & Geriatrics as part of the Social Medicine program that was created by CCC and OHSU in 2006. The Social Medicine program operates from Old Town Clinic and is a training ground for OHSU's medical residents, giving them an opportunity to experience how social forces affect health. The Old Town Clinic serves homeless and very low income individuals.

Dr. Engstrom will see patients at Old Town Clinic in addition to teaching and mentoring OHSU internal medicine interns and residents. He has been a practicing primary care provider for 17 years and has established a reputation for both his clinical expertise and his dedication to serving disadvantaged populations. In addition to his work for Multnomah County Health Department's clinics and corrections health programs, Dr. Engstrom has traveled internationally as a volunteer physician in Honduras, Pakistan, West Africa, and Kenya.

Dr. Engstrom is a graduate of the Northwestern University Medical School and completed his internal medicine residency training at Virginia Mason Hospital in Seattle.
