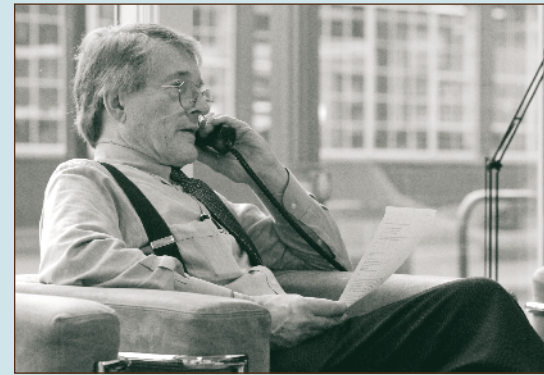

George "Bing" Sheldon is a founding board member of Central City Concern, and has served on the board of directors since 1979. Bing is the principal of SERA Architects and a Fellow of the American Institute of Architects. He has nationally recognized expertise in historic buildings and has played a pivotal role in Portland's downtown renaissance, stressing urban infill, reuse and redevelopment as important strategies for creating a new sense of community. He believes that Portlanders have a moral obligation to actively participate in the civic infrastructure which reflects our community values. Bing has served on numerous boards and commissions, including chairing the Portland Planning Commission during the 1970s, a period of tremendous revitalization in the downtown area and development of Portland's groundbreaking transportation system. He served as a board chair for the Portland Art Museum, and on the boards of the Urban Growth Committee of the AIA Portland Chapter, Portland Classical Chinese Garden, Mt. Hood Cultural Center and Museum and Arts Plan 2000+. He has been an active board member for a number of organizations serving development needs within the downtown and Old Town neighborhoods, including roles with the Portland Landmark Commission, Old Town History Project and National Trust for Historic Preservation.
