As part of our policy and commitment to a drug and alcohol-free workplace we conduct post-offer, pre-employment drug screens.

On Call employees must work at least once in every 6 month period to remain active on payroll.

Position Summary: This physician conducts histories and physicals on clients for BEST for the purpose of disability determination. A background working with homeless and under-served populations is preferred. Demonstrated skills in primary care medicine, an unrestricted licensure to practice medicine in Oregon is required of all applicants. All appointments will be scheduled according to the physician's availability.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

1. Ability to perform physical assessments based on chart notes and a physical examination.
2. Determines and formulates health histories and diagnoses.
3. Ability and willingness to give a prognosis based on information gathered from exam.
4. Willingness to collaborate with BEST members in indentifying the severity of client's impairments.
5. Dictates a thorough report of client's impairments, history, severity and prognosis.
6. Perform other duties as assigned.

Skills and Abilities:

1. Ability to interact with co-workers, patients and staff to instill confidence and facilitate communication.
2. Ability to display non-judgmental attitude.
3. Sufficient manual dexterity and physical ability to perform assigned tasks.
4. Ability to manage time and complete reports in a timely manner.
5. Knowledge of de-escalation methods or willing to be trained in these methods.

Minimum Qualifications:

1. Experience in urgent care and/or primary care practice. Unlimited medical license in Oregon.
2. Must have availability during the hours between 9:00am and 6:00pm.
3. If a recovering chemically dependent person, must be in an on-going program of recovery with two (2) years demonstrated level of sobriety.

4. Must pass pre-employment drug screen, TB test and background check.
5. Physical ability to bend, stoop, kneel, squat, twist, reach, pull and lift moderately heavy objects.
6. Must adhere to agency's policies, including but not limited to, non-discrimination, safety, drug and alcohol-free workplace, violence prevention and harassment-free workplace.
7. Ability to effectively interact with co-workers and clients with diverse ethnic backgrounds, religious views, cultural backgrounds, life-styles and sexual orientations and treat each individual with respect and dignity.
