This may be an ideal opportunity for an individual with excellent customer service skills looking for a way to interact directly with our patient population and make an immediate contribution to their quality of care. DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES:

1. Greet patients entering the Old Town Clinic through the main entrance
2. Ask about the purpose(s) of their visit
3. Escort the patient to the appropriate Clinic space
4. Answer questions when possible and find appropriate staff members when needed
5. Communicate effectively with patients and Old Town Clinic staff members

SKILLS AND ABILITIES:

1. Considerable customer service experience desired; warm, patient, and calm demeanor
2. Previous experience in a clinic setting is helpful
3. History of reliable work and/or volunteer performance
4. Able to volunteer on a consistent schedule
5. Due to confidentiality issues, individuals who have received services from any CCC program in the past two years are not eligible for this position.
6. Ability to handle sensitive and confidential information on a regular basis.
7. Ability to stand for medium-to-long periods of time
8. Ability to take direction and guidance
9. Ability to effectively interact with employees and clients with diverse ethnic backgrounds, religious views, political affiliation, cultural backgrounds, lifestyles, and sexual orientations and treat each individual with respect and dignity
10. Volunteer is required to attend New Volunteer Orientation
